Council Tax Support Grant 2013/14

We reported in the 2013/14 audit report that Council Tax Support Grant of £148 had been incorrectly included in Box 2. The Council has not restated the comparative figures for 2013/14. Box 2 should state £1,352 and Box 3 should state £234 in the 2014 column on the 2015 Annual Return.

Timing of internal audit

The council completed Section 2 of the Annual Return – the annual governance statement on 28 May 2015, and has responded "Yes" to assertion 6, confirming that the council has maintained throughout the year an adequate and effective system of internal audit of the council's accounting records and control systems.

Section 4, the independent internal auditor's report was completed by the internal auditor on 18 June 2015, 21 days after the council gave a positive response to assertion 6 on Section 2 of the Annual Return.
